



Swan 46 MK1 & MK2

Nautor started building the 46 MK1 in 1983 and it was only in 1990 that the 46 MK2 saw light. Both the MK1 and MK2 were designed by the well known and very experienced German Frers. The MK1 & MK2 have the same hull with the MK2 carrying more sail and a deeper keel. Despite the extra sail surface, the MK2 proved 20 % stiffer than the MK1. Also the interior of the MK2 was reworked and the bulkhead at the mast was moved in order to create more space.

Both the MK1 & 2 have shown their potential over the years with consecutive wins at the Swan Cup in Porto Cervo & Cowes.

Despite their age, Swan's 46 are still considered fast and comfortable cruising

yachts, easy to handle by a 2 person crew even in more windy conditions.

Swan's 46 are enjoyed by owners all over the world from Scandinavia to the Mediterranean, North America, Australia and Asia.

Today no communication platform exists for the owners to share their passion for the Swan 46. Exchanging experiences in cruising, racing and maintaining of these beautiful yachts there for proved difficult.
